- 2. If you or someone in your home has CO poisoning, get out of the house right away. Call 911, your local fire department, or local emergency medical service from a nearby phone.
- 3. If kids play with oven knobs, they could turn the gas on by mistake.
- 4. Answers will vary.
- 5. If you smell natural gas in you home, you should not use fire or electricity—a spark from a match, phone, or electrical device (even a doorbell or radio) could ignite the gas and cause a fire.
- 6. If you smell natural gas in your home, you should leave the area immediately and move to a safe location. Ask a trusted adult to call 911 and the local natural gas utility. Warn others to stay away.
